Dear Parents and Friends of West Michigan Lutheran High School,

First Semester Exams: First Semester Exams will be given Wednesday, December 16, through Friday, December 18. There will be half-days of school for students on these three days. The school day will start at 8:00 a.m. and exams will be completed by 11:15 a.m. Students are dismissed for the afternoon and there is no hot lunch served these three days. The complete exam schedule is attached.

If school is canceled on Tuesday, December 15, the first exams will be held on Wednesday as scheduled. If school is canceled on an exam day, the exams from the canceled day will be given the next school day. If school is canceled on Friday, December 18, those exams will not be given on Monday, January 4, but will be rescheduled later that week.

The last day of school for first semester is Friday, January 15.

Christmas Vacation: There is no school for students from Monday, December 21, through Friday, January 1. School resumes on Monday, January 4.


The girls varsity basketball game cancelled on December 4 has been rescheduled for Monday, February 1, at 6:30 pm at Tri-Unity Christian.
